Qualifications are issued by MINTS ("Miami International Seminary"), which is registered with the state of Florida's Department of Education, in Dade County, Florida, U.S.A. At present, Filadelfia Biblical Counselling Institute is in the process of registering as a private provider of training in South Africa, at DHET, CHE and SETA.
